Paletteers Summer Art Show 2016

THEME: There is no theme for this show. Artists may enter three works in the show as well as smaller less expensive items (8X10 and \$100 or under) in the Collector's Corner.

JUDGING: Because the library has an Author Night on Thursday of Heritage Week, we need to have the judging and the opening reception on **Tuesday July 26th**. We had quite a lot of discussion about potential judges and settled on four people to solicit as judges, sharing the responsibility among the board. Ribbons are on order. The People's Choice Award will be selected on Sat. July 30th.

MUSIC: Melinde and Sandy Weaver will be playing some background music for part of the reception time on July 26th.... Probably two 15-minute sets.

BOOKING: We need to book the time for judging on Tuesday am with the Library. Dee volunteered to do that this week (and the Thurs. am judging time in their schedule can be cancelled).

REFRESHMENTS: Clara and Jan will be working on arranging for finger food platters and drinks for the Summer Show.

RAFFLE: Three of our artists are submitting work to be raffled this year: Kathy Ravenhorst-Adams, John Weaver and Clara Gheist. The Raffle winners will be chosen on Sat. July 30th.

CLOSING TIME: The show will end on Sat. July 30th at 3 pm. Past experience tells us that this is the best time to end the show. Artists may pick up their artwork on Saturday July 30 after 3 pm or on Monday from 10 – noon. On Monday you may need to ring the bell or get the attention of workers inside, as the library is not open to the public at that time.

Upcoming Events: There is interest in Bev Shevis sharing information about her enamel work in 2017.

Tableau painting has been postponed from July 30th at Currier Park to **Sept. 17th** as part of our Plein-Aire Paint-Out day. We have the Milne Rm. scheduled in the Library calendar as a rain space from 10-1 pm.

Card Making Clinic: we have decided to organize a card-making clinic on **Saturday Sept. 10th**. The plan is for people to bring in card pieces that will be photographed and put on a drive to be printed at Copy World into standard cards and envelopes. The objective is to sell cards during the holiday season to raise money for the Scholarship Fund. The time of this event is 10 am to noon.

Oct. 11 is the date for the opening/reception for the Paletteers' Fall Art Show. This will include a member mtg. and be open to the public. Finger foods and punch will be refreshments. This is the venue in which we may be incorporating miniatures.

Our Holiday Party will be on **Dec. 6th**. The board is considering a luncheon at Cornerstone Pub.

The board will meet on **July 12th** at 5:30 in the Milne Rm. to finalize plans for the art show. At that time we will be discussing "miniatures" as a future theme and a card making clinic on Sept. 10.
